


UbuntuNet Open Science Cloud




Servers: Infrastructure in Lusaka (Zambia) and Kigali (Rwanda)

Provides near-term sustainability of UOSC



Institutional repositories: For small institutions whose research output cannot justify the required staff complement and where NRENs do not exist or support hosting of institutional repositories







Required textbooks on course syllabi are often unavailable in the universities' libraries, with those that are available, frequently out of date or not directly relevant to the courses on offer



Available locally, on devices "for life" and can sync between multiple platforms

Digital rights management of content, still owned by authors



DOA Textbooks





Platform under testing and shall go live in January 2025

App navigation and books are available in English, French and Portuguese

Currently two books published for testing

Funds available (EC and Member NRENs) through 2028 to support: Continued infrastructure development and maintenance

Funds to publish at least **50 textbooks** (payments to authors licensing fees, costs of professional publishing) through 2028
