1. WILL THE PROGRAMME BE DELIVERED IN MULTIPLE LANGUAGES?

The Diamond Open Access and the Open Science in the South Conferences will be presented in English. However, simultaneous translation into French, Spanish, Portuguese, and Swahili will be available. Please note that simultaneous translations will not be available for any other events in the conference programme.

2. WILL THE PROGRAMME BE IN PERSON ONLY OR HYBRID?

The Diamond Open Access Conference will be available in a hybrid format, however the Open Science in the South and Department of Knowledge and Information Stewardship Conferences will only be available in-person.
