Weather and clothing



Summer begins in December in Cape Town so you can expect the weather to be very warm, averaging at least 25 - 27 **degrees Celsius** each day. The evenings are cooler but still pleasantly warm. All the indoor venues and the hotel will have air-conditioning.

Rainfall is rare during summer in Cape Town as this is the dry season. Humidity levels are low in the Western Cape but the UV levels are high during the day while the breeze remains cool and refreshing.

We suggest using a strong sunscreen. Hats are encouraged.

There is a saying that Cape Town has all four seasons in one day because the weather can be very unpredictable at times but overall, we expect (and hope) the weather will be warm and pleasant.

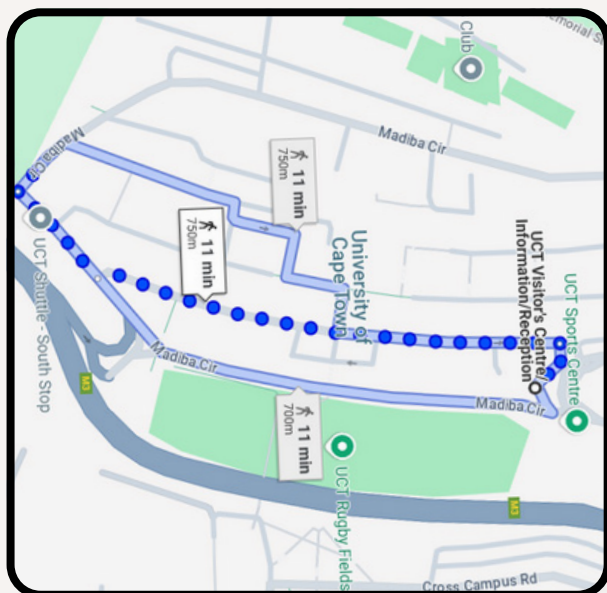
Navigating UCT campus
